You will receive a single offer of a secondary school place depending on

- your preference
- the admissions criteria of the school
- spaces available (PAN number)

Allocation letters will be sent by the Local Authority on 1st March 2023.



ADMISSIONS

The Local Authority is following Government guidance by operating an "equal preference" scheme.

This means you can apply for up to three secondary schools and rank them in preference order.

Each of your three preferences will be given equal weight by the named schools, subject to each school's admissions criteria.



ADMISSIONS PAN: 80

Broadly over last five years:

25% Roman Catholic, 25% other Christian/other faith, 50% other reasons for preference.

Last Year:

82 applications for 80 places

- 44 first choice applications
- 22 second choice applications
- 16 third choice applications
