The Catholic Virtues - Rewards

Prudence (Wisdom) When we demonstrate prudence, we receive rewards for excellent **classwork**, homework, and when we show that we are really making progress in our learning by showing clear knowledge and **understanding** of the topic we are working on.



Fortitude (Courage) When we demonstrate fortitude, we receive rewards for being brave by answering questions, volunteering, having a go when we find the work difficult, persevering and showing that we are willing to overcome any difficulties in our learning by not giving up.



Temperance (Self-Control) When we demonstrate *temperance,* we receive rewards for being able to control our behaviour by not being silly, making appropriate contribution to class discussion, speaking to all adults and each other with respect, listening and concentrating, and playing by the rules.



Justice (Fairness) When we demonstrate justice we receive rewards for being fair, owning up when we make a mistake, taking on roles of responsibility to make positive changes to our school and the world in which we live, and for standing up for what is right.
